



## EKG #16

### PSVT-Supraventricular Tachycardia Non Specific ST, T Wave Changes

- The mechanism is commonly orthodromic AV reentry, (Antegrade conduction through normal pathway, retrograde conduction to the atria through the accessory pathway.)
- P waves often not easily identified.
- ST depression not a reliable indicator of ischemia.
