Patient Information: Uroflow – bladder scan

A Uroflow - bladder scan is a non-invasive test that measures the volume and velocity of urine flow and the residual urine in the bladder.

1) Preparation:

- a) You should come to the clinic 10 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.
- b) Please come to the clinic with a full bladder. The results may be inconclusive if your bladder is not full before the test.

2) What to do when you arrive at our clinic?

- a) Please check in at the front desk when you arrive. If you feel that you cannot hold your urine any longer, let one of our staff know. We will make every attempt to complete the test immediately.
- b) If your bladder is not full when you arrive, you may wait in the clinic area.
