Care after a cystoscopy

1. Mild side effects are common after a cystoscopy and will resolve within 48 hours. These common side effects include:
 - A. Small amounts of blood or small blood clots. (If this occurs, please drink additional fluids until your urine is clear.)
 - B. Slight burning sensation when you urinate.
 - C. The urge to urinate more frequently than usual.
2. If you have any of the following symptoms, seek medical attention immediately.
 - A. Temperature greater than 101.5 degrees Fahrenheit
 - B. Shaking and or chills
 - C. Marked amount of blood in urine that does not resolve with increased hydration.
 - D. Inability to urinate, despite a full bladder.
 - E. Burning or pain that does not goes away after 48 hours.
